The following are a few ways parents can increase their children's excitement about reading:

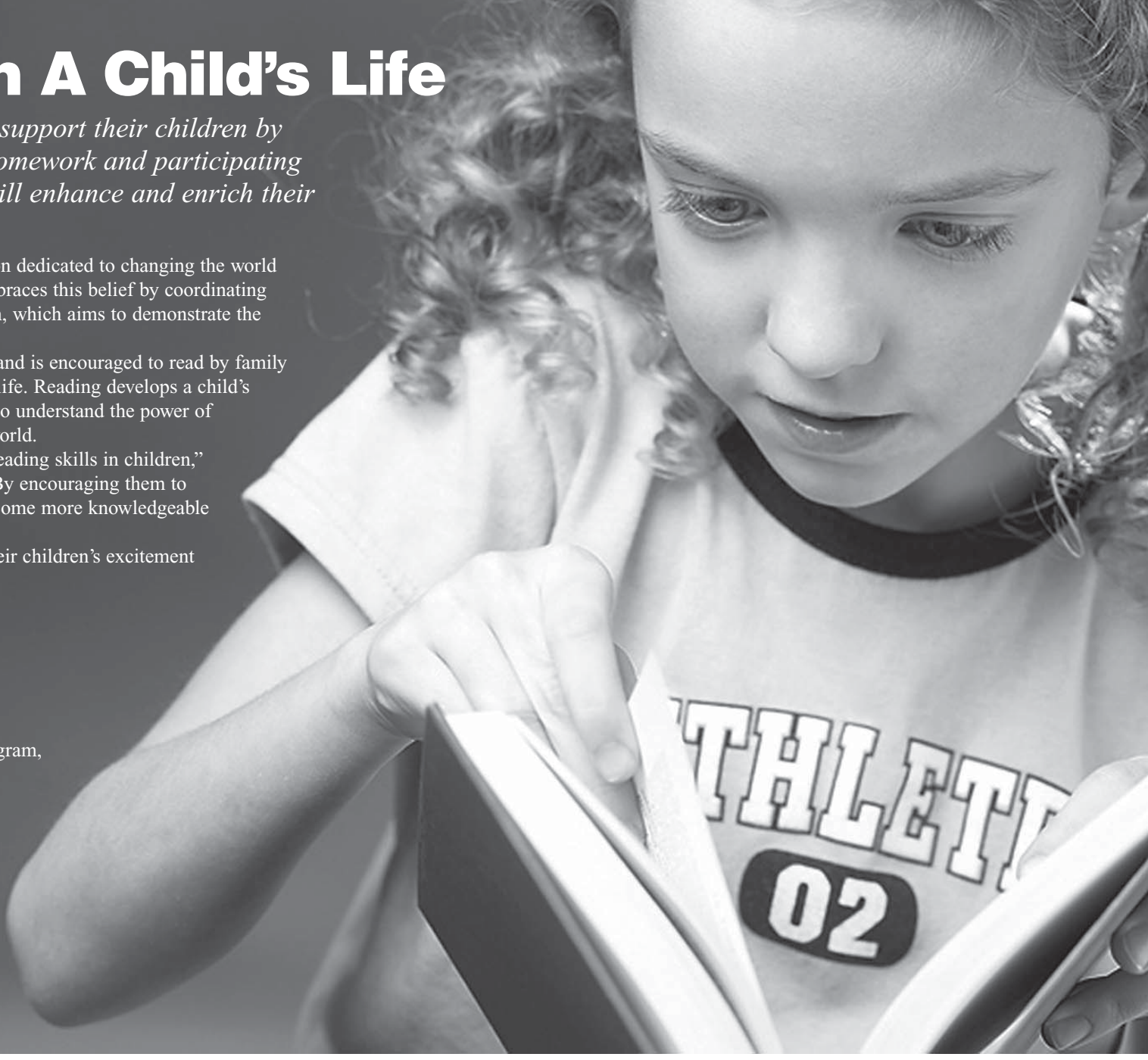
- **Hold a book party**
