

# Support a Cancer Center, WIN a new home!

Mee Health Systems has launched one of the most exciting projects in its history, the Mee Memorial Cancer Center, and supporters have the opportunity to win a brand new home.

To help get the project off the ground, Mee Health Systems is raffling a one-of-a-kind wine country villa. Located in the heart of Central Coast wine country on Paso Robles' beautiful west side, the custom-built home is an entertainer's dream.

Huge windows and French doors open up to lovely patios and an outdoor cooking area and to a country view beyond. Special touches include a temperature-controlled wine cellar with handpainted mural and a built-in sound system throughout the house and patio areas. The master suite includes a redwood sauna, soaking tub with nearby gas fireplace and an enormous walk-in closet. Other amenities include cathedral ceilings, Travertine slab counters, handmade tile throughout and a Viking cooktop. The 2300

square foot home offers three bedrooms, two bathrooms and a two-car garage.
