going, Green said. At CSUMB, counselors are available to help with emotional problems.

"Also a health and counseling center if they're feeling overwhelmed by anything," Green said. "Even boyfriend-girlfriend problems."

At UCLA, Ngo will live in a dorm with a roommate, whom he has not yet met. He expects to feel homesick in the early going.

"Because my family is always a prime support," Ngo said. "I'll call them, though. I'll visit during vacations."

Oropeza will have two roommates. A few close friends from Salinas High will also attend Berkeley.

"It'll be nice to have that security," she said.

To better prepare herself for campus life, Oropeza has quizzed her older brother and sister, both of whom have college experience.

"I'm really looking forward to expanding my own experiences at Berkeley," she said.

Not everyone at the moment of high school graduation is ready for college, Gray said.

"A lot of students don't know what to do, so they go to college," she said. "They get there without a goal and they're not really successful."

It may make more sense to take a year in the workplace, she said. Students who do get a job for awhile after high school often opt for college later. By then they have a more mature and purpose-driven attitude, Gray said.
