But it's also a place for rodeo novices to check out the sport while enjoying music, food and a burgeoning party scene.

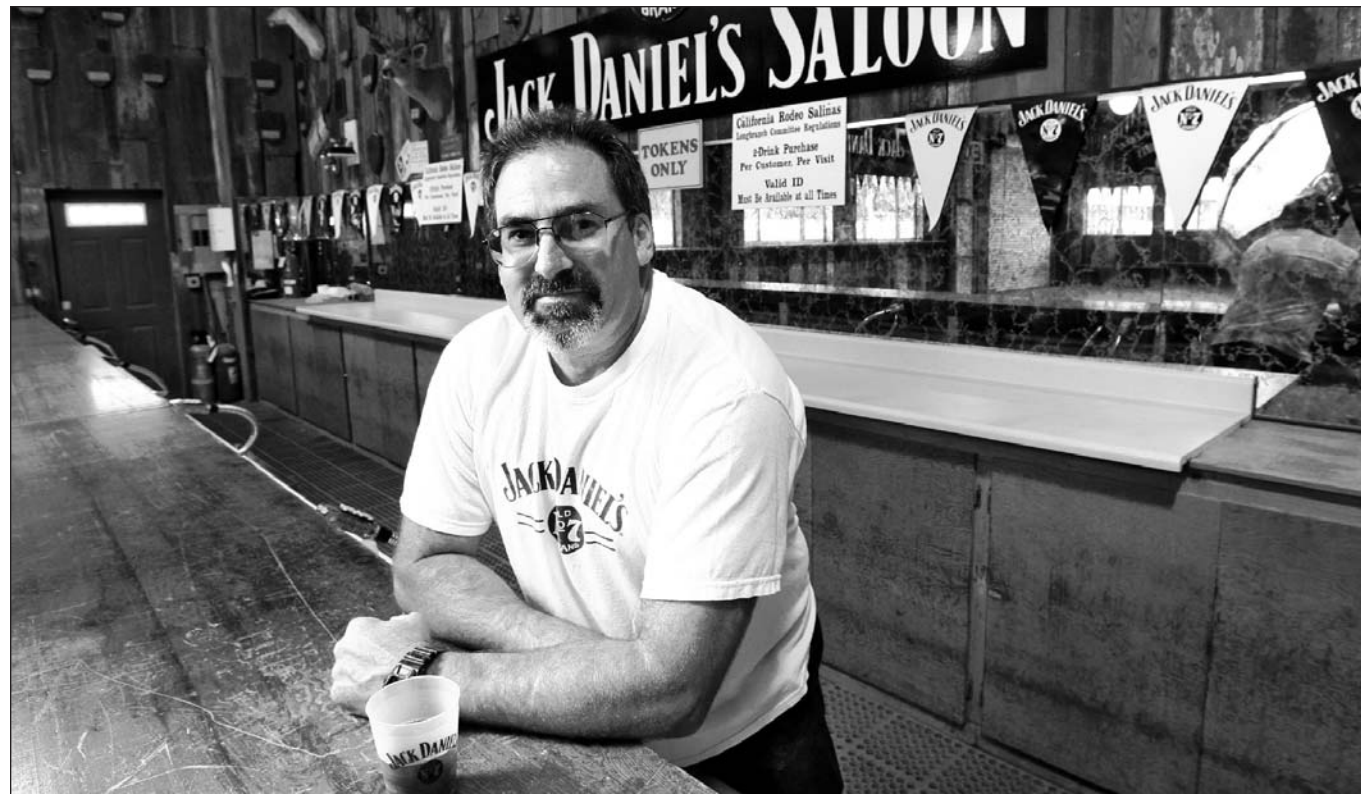
The choices are many, for Rodeo aficionados and fun-seekers alike.
