

2005 ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE INDEX (API) BASE RESULTS



The following chart shows how Monterey County school districts and their school sites performed on statewide student tests administered in spring 2005. Schools that fall below 800 points on the API's scale of 200 to 1,000 points are required to meet annual growth targets until they reach 800.

- n **2005 API BASE:** The school/district's score on tests last spring. This spring's test scores will be compared with the base score to measure improvement.
- n **2005 STATEWIDE RANK:** How the school compares with all California schools.
- n **2005 SIMILAR SCHOOLS RANK:** How the school compares with sites of similar demographics.
- n **2005-06 GROWTH TARGET:** The number of points schools need to gain from tests this spring.
- n **2006 API TARGET:** The points schools should have after tests this spring.
