

# Hartnell builds on future

*New library, parking garage are just the beginning of campus improvements*

Years of planning and construction paid off at Hartnell College in Salinas for this spring semester, with the opening of the campus' new 1,100-space parking facility in January and the completion of its new library expected in May.

"I'm very pleased with the product," said Stan Crane, assistant to the president on the projects. "We've come up with two really, really nice buildings, and I can't wait to have people able to come in and visit the library."

While the building will be open for tours and visits by the public, the materials and 55,000 books in the old library won't be transferred to the new
